

Types of Handbags

Bucket Bag

A bucket bag is a round, large or medium-sized bag, shaped like a bucket, with shoulder straps and a drawstring closure.



Hobo Bag

A hobo bag is a medium-sized, crescent-shaped bag with a top zipper and often a slouch or dip in the centre.



Tote

A tote is a medium to large bag with two straps and an open-top.



Cross Body

A cross-body has one long strap that crosses over the body, with the bag resting at the front by the waist.



Sling Bag

A sling bag has one long, wide strap that crosses over the body, with the bag resting on the back.



Shoulder Bag

A shoulder bag is any bag with shoulder-length straps.
